

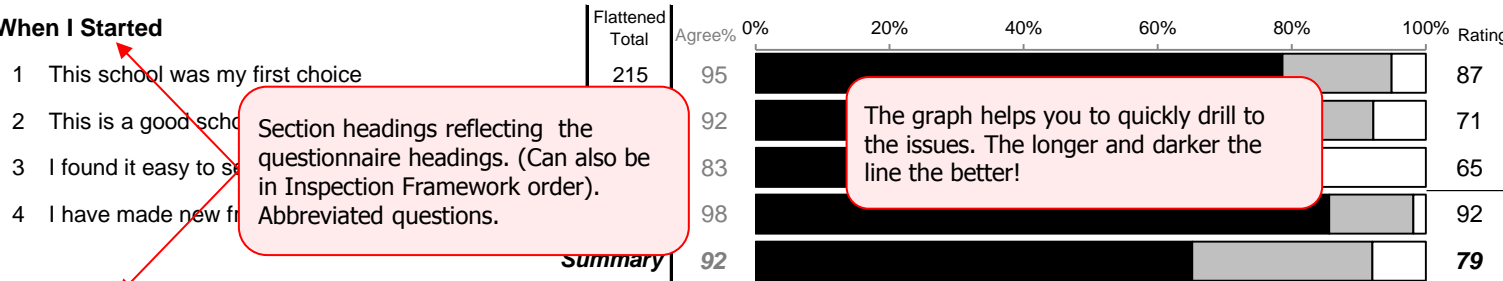

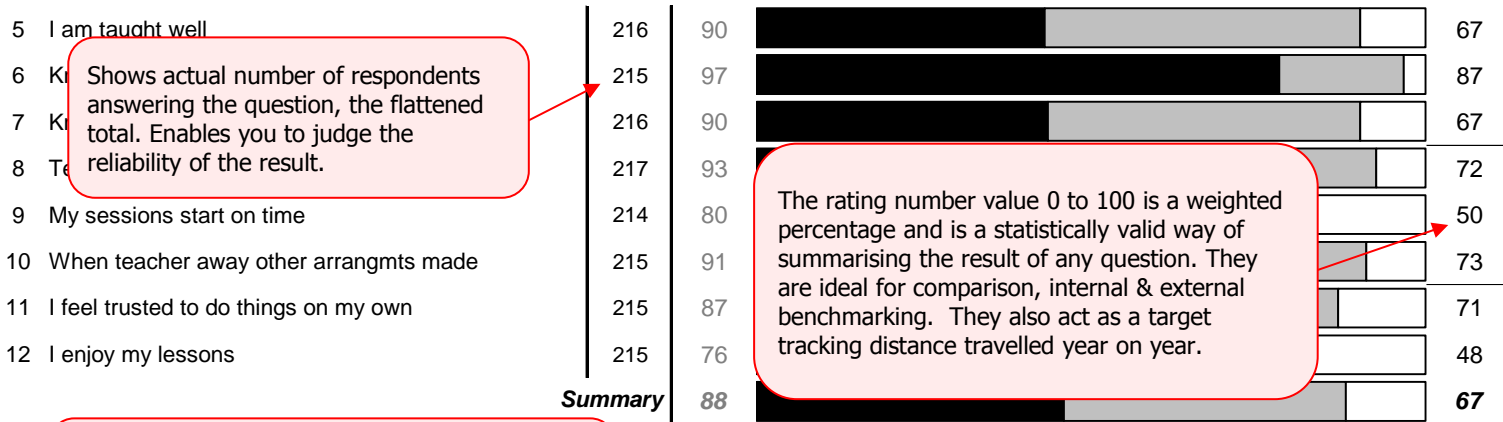


Section headings reflecting the questionnaire headings. (Can also be in Inspection Framework order). Abbreviated questions.

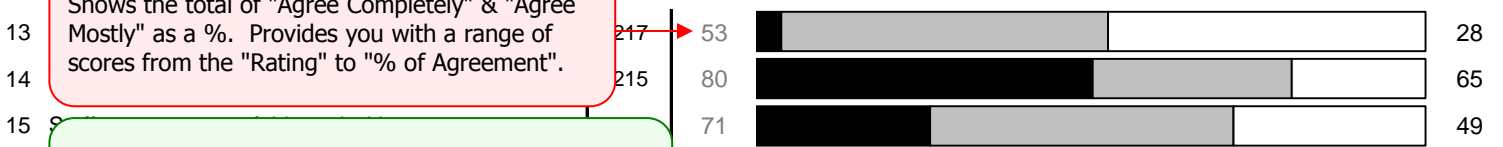


Shows actual number of respondents answering the question, the flattened total. Enables you to judge the reliability of the result.
