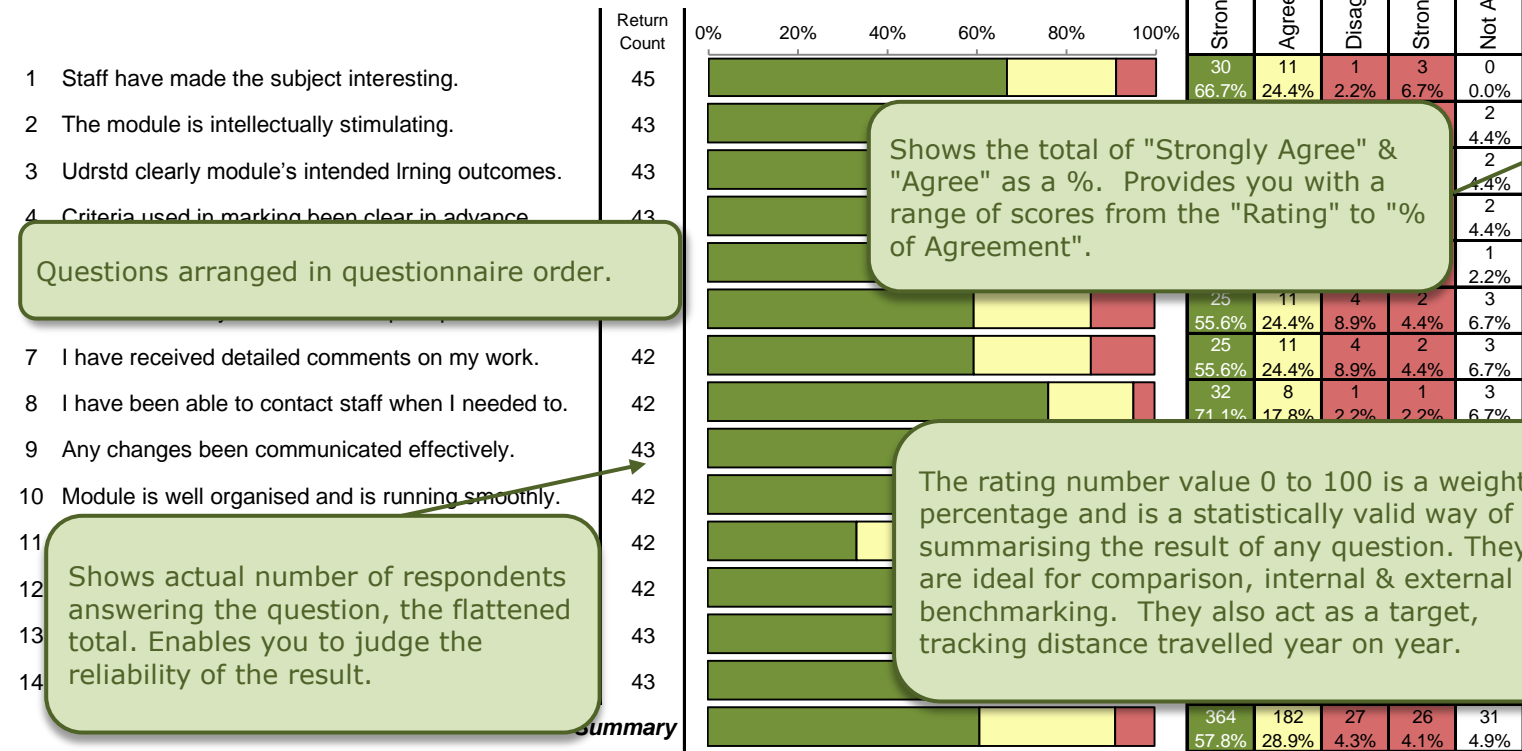
Example 4: Graphical with External Benchmark Report

Shows actual number of respondents answering the question, the flattened total. Enables you to judge the reliability of the result.

Shows the total of "Strongly Agree" & "Agree" as a %. Provides you with a range of scores from the "Rating" to "% of Agreement".

The rating number value 0 to 100 is a weighted percentage and is a statistically valid way of summarising the result of any question. They are ideal for comparison, internal & external benchmarking. They also act as a target, tracking distance travelled year on year.
